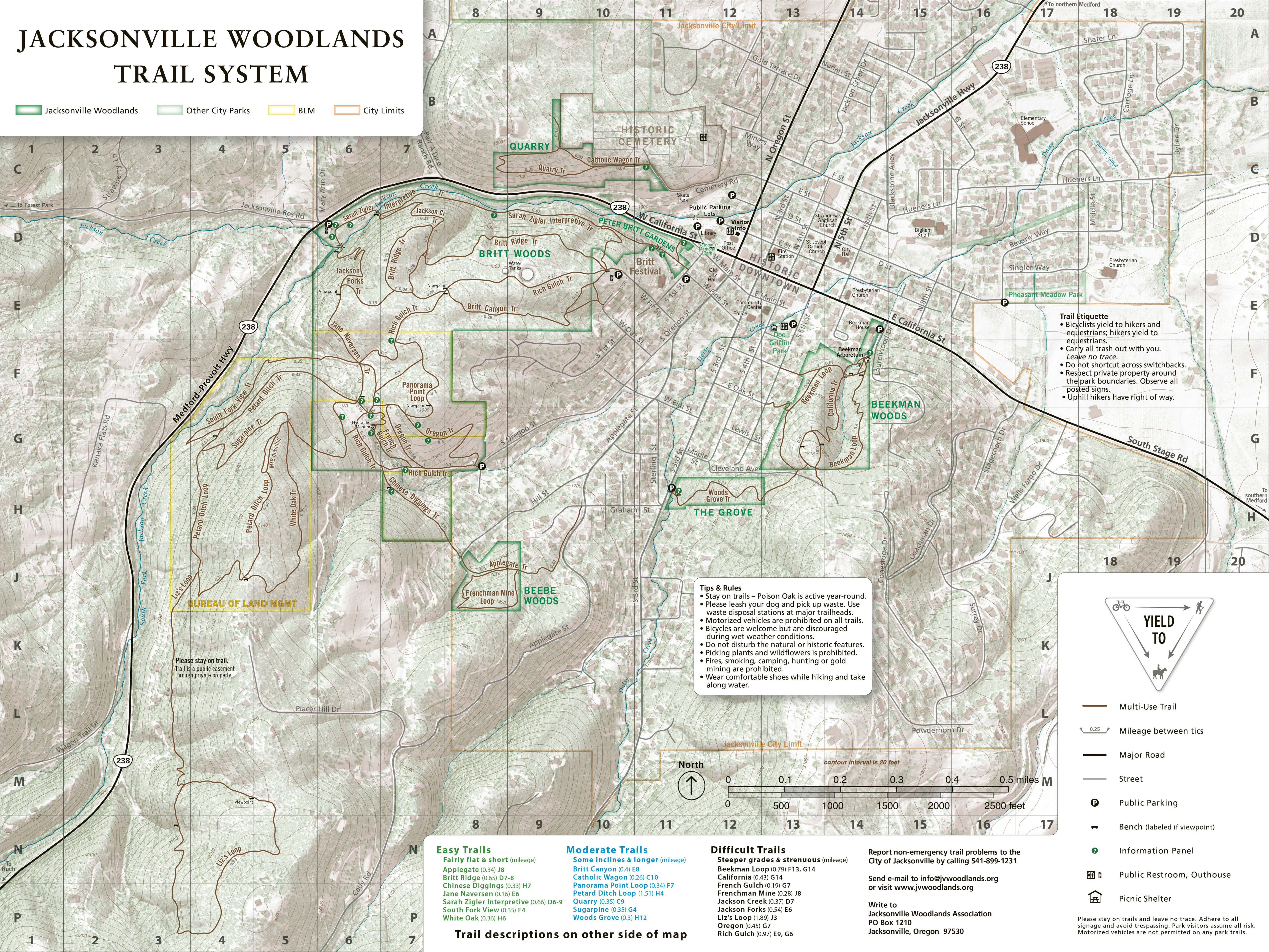


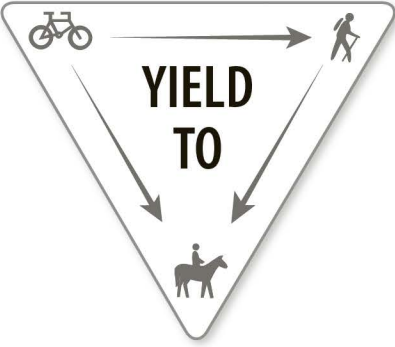
JACKSONVILLE WOODLANDS TRAIL SYSTEM

Jacksonville Woodlands Other City Parks BLM City Limits



- Trail Etiquette**
- Bicyclists yield to hikers and equestrians; hikers yield to equestrians.
 - Carry all trash out with you. *Leave no trace.*
 - Do not shortcut across switchbacks.
 - Respect private property around the park boundaries. Observe all posted signs.
 - Uphill hikers have right of way.

- Tips & Rules**
- Stay on trails – Poison Oak is active year-round.
 - Please leash your dog and pick up waste. Use waste disposal stations at major trailheads.
 - Motorized vehicles are prohibited on all trails.
 - Bicycles are welcome but are discouraged during wet weather conditions.
 - Do not disturb the natural or historic features.
 - Picking plants and wildflowers is prohibited.
 - Fires, smoking, camping, hunting or gold mining are prohibited.
 - Wear comfortable shoes while hiking and take along water.
