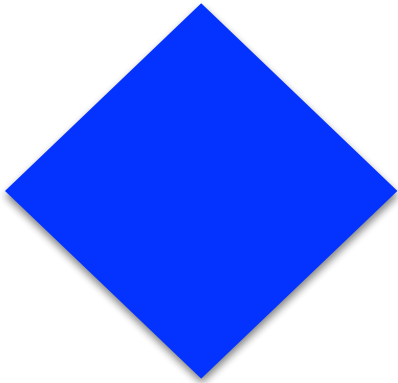
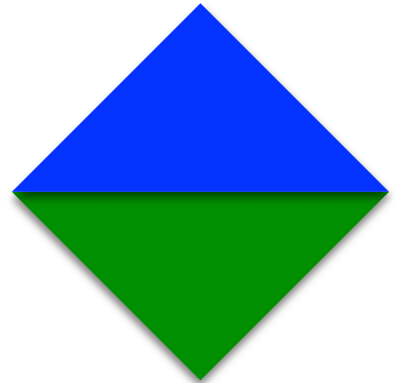


3 mile loop- blue and blue-green diamonds



One of the park's more popular loops, this hike takes you up the historic Bullis Railroad grade past a replica trestle at the site of an historic tragedy. Continuing upstream, you'll pass waterfalls on Jackson Creek before returning through historic mining sites.



Loop runs counter-clockwise from P1, sharing first mile and about last 2 miles with 6-mile (green) loop

From P1, cross the Rail Bridge and follow Rail Tr, past Ponderosa Snag Tr, along the east side of the old reservoir and then up a slight grade before arriving at the replica train trestle. Continue past Ponderosa Snag, Siskiyou Spur, and at Rattlesnake Gulch Tr veer left to cross Reservoir Rd and Narrows Bridge. Turn right on Norling Tr and head upstream to the Canyon Falls Tr. Turn left and follow Canyon Falls Tr upstream, past waterfalls, crossing Ol' Miners Tr, climbing stairs, and crossing Canyon Falls Bridge as you climb up to Boulder Trail. Turn left onto Boulder Tr and follow it to an intersection that heads down to Ol' Miners' Tr (you can turn here, or continue on Boulder Tr to the next junction). Turn right and follow Ol' Miners' Tr, passing a junction down to P2, continuing on Ol' Miners Tr. Soon you'll arrive at a spur trail down to the historic mine tunnel. Continue down through a hydraulic mining area to the finish at P1. 4/20
